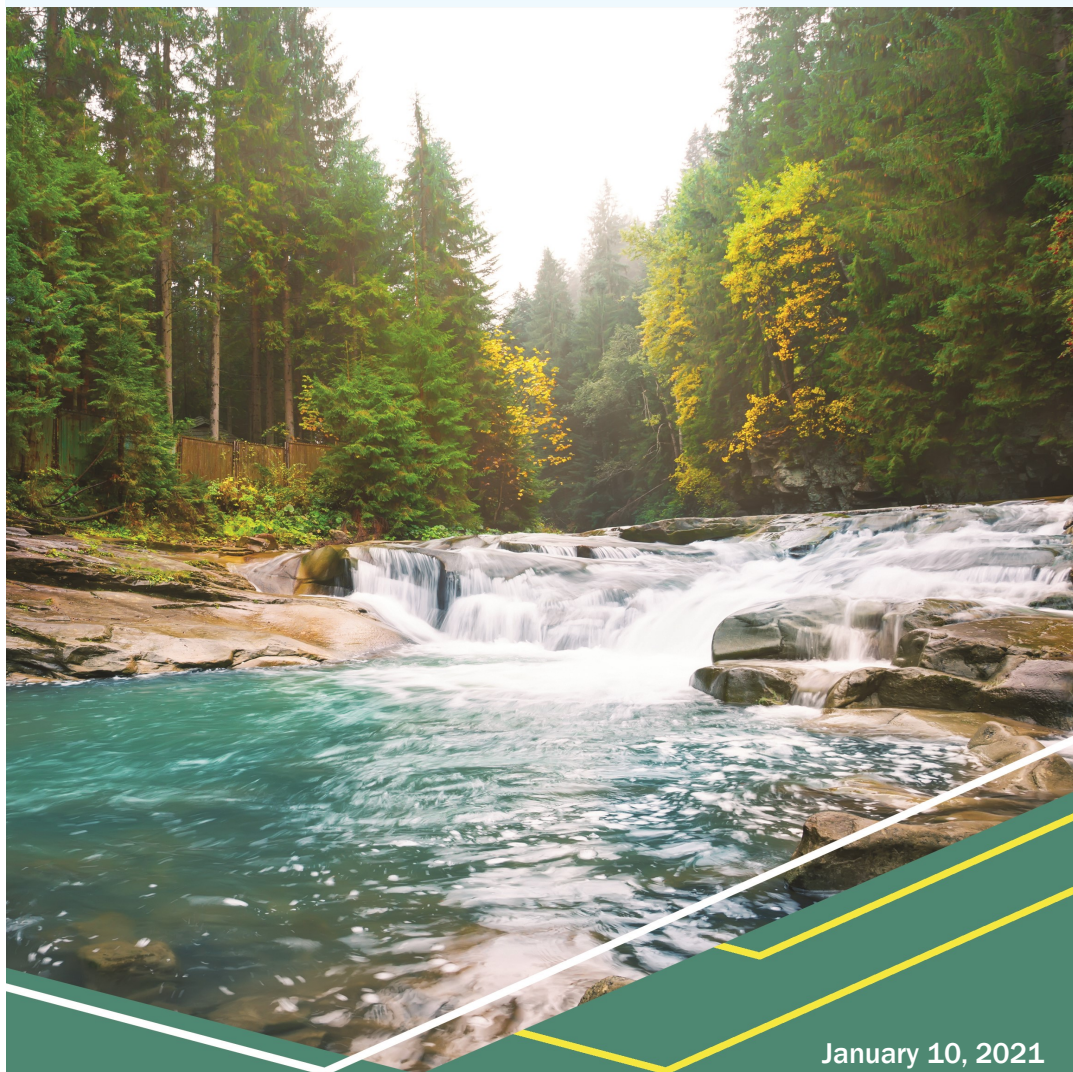

For Family to Family, we sponsored 10 families from the Maria Reina de la Paz Parish in Hartford for a total of 75 people.

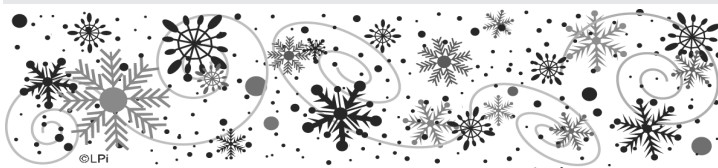
