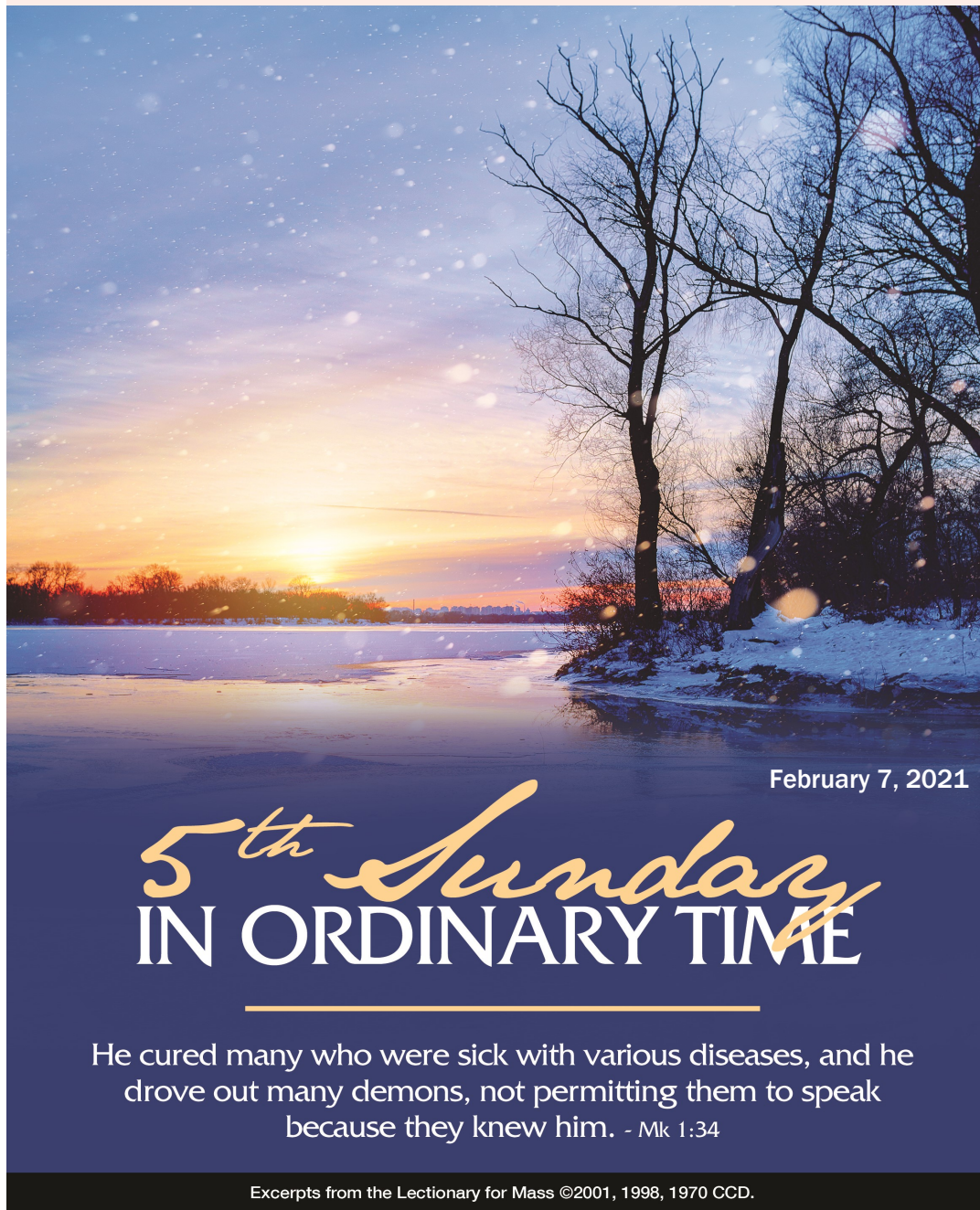

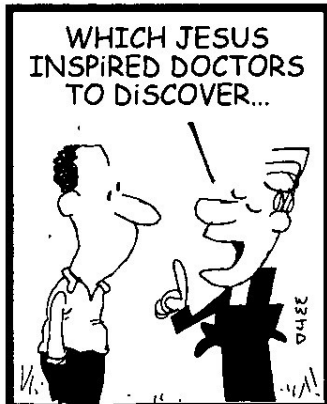
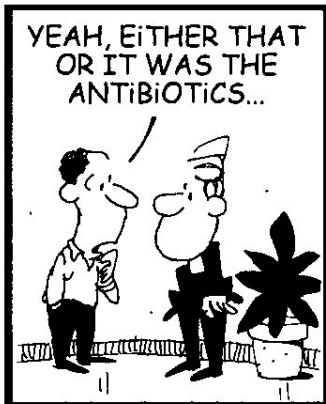

- March 30th

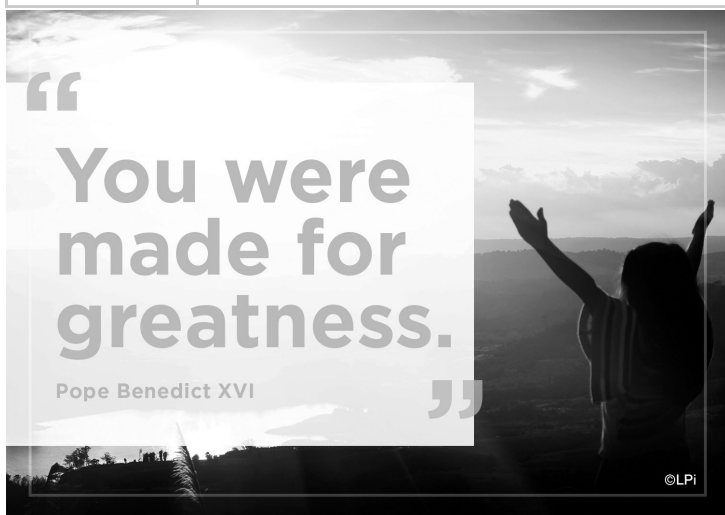
