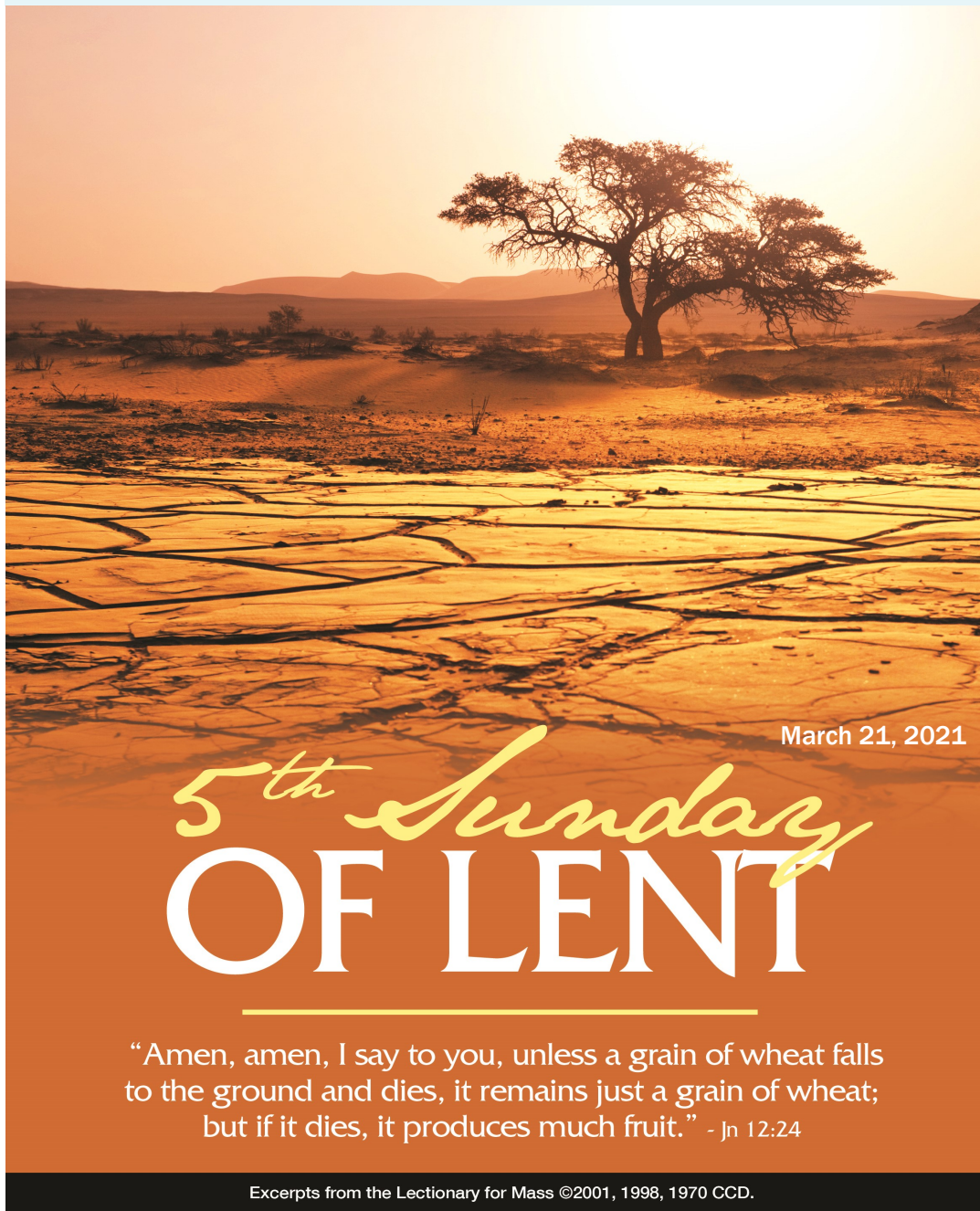

Lent began on Ash Wednesday, **February 17, 2021** until just prior to the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday, **April 1st, 2021**

For those whose health permits, **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are **days of fast** and **abstinence**. All **Fridays** in Lent are days of **abstinence**. **Fasting** means to refrain from eating foods between meals and to eat only one full meal with the other two being lighter meals. It is required of those who are age 18 to 59 on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. **Abstinence** means to refrain from eating meat. It is required of those age 14 and older on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday** and all **Fridays in Lent**

Holy Hour and Eucharistic Adoration with vespers: Every Wednesday 7.00 pm
