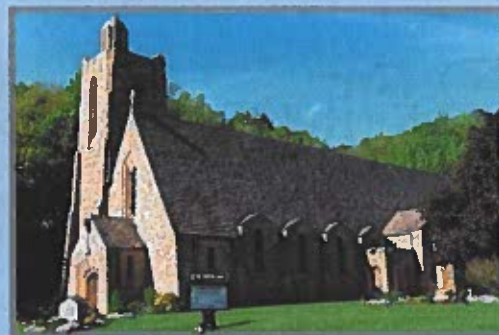

From the Faith Formation Coordinator:

We are looking ahead with hope to the 2021-2022 Faith Formation year for children and youth at St. Patrick. Registration for Grades 1, 3 through 8, along with registration for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation years 1 and 2 will begin **June 1 lasting until July 15.**

Registrations received after July 15 will incur a \$10.00 per child fee increase.

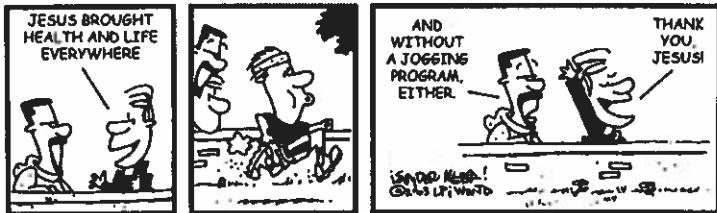
Mass Intentions Available
