**From the Faith Formation Coordinator:**

**Thank you to the families that have registered your children for Faith Formation.** We understand this summer was different. Families traveled to see loved ones, or just got away to decompress and relax. We therefore have extended Registration for Grades 1, 3 through 8, and registration for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation years 1 and 2 until August 1. **Registrations received after August 1 will incur a \$10.00 per child fee increase.**

Faith Formation will begin Sunday, September 26th. Classes will take place on Sundays in person starting at 9:00 AM and concluding at 9:50 AM (just in time for 10:00 AM Mass). All students will be provided a St. Patrick Faith Formation Google G-Suite account like last year. It will be used by Catechists as a secure means for students to turn in classwork, communicate with parents/students and Google Meet classes.

We anticipate a total of 12 in person, and 5 Google Meet classes for General Faith Formation. Sacrament classes will provide their own schedule. To prevent overcrowding in the Hall, classes will be broken into two groups. Group A will be grades 1, 3, 4, 5 and Group B will be grades 6, 7 and 8. Each group will meet every other week. Grades will be spaced using the stage and partitioning of the Parish Hall. A reasonable amount of Social Distancing will be maintained between students. All classroom areas will be sanitized weekly, and hand sanitizer will be available.

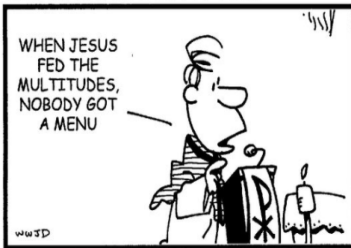
### **Modification of Safety Practices Regarding COVID -19**
