 and Confirmation Faith Formation Year!**

First Holy Communion/Reconciliation preparation takes place during the second grade year with reception of the sacrament after Easter. It is considered one of the holiest and most important occasions in a Roman Catholic's life. It means your child has received the Sacrament of Reconciliation leading to receiving the Sacrament of the First Eucharist.

Confirmation preparation takes place during grades 9 and 10. When we are Confirmed we receive special graces by which our faith is strengthened. Confirmation is the Catholic sacrament of mature Christian life and a deepening of baptismal graces. It is one of the three Sacraments of Initiation and most often associated with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Don't let these significant moments, where your children will learn about the special Graces they are about to receive, pass you by.
