2021 Theme: *In the Spirit of Trust*

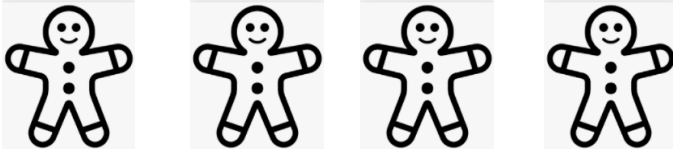
