No previous music background is needed.

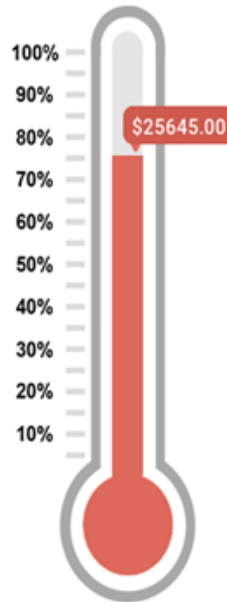
