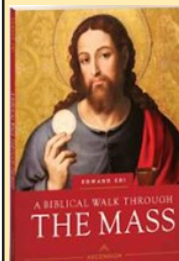
Sparkle for Hope: An Evening of Fun and Connection!

We've started our Cemetery Beautification Program. Work has begun to clean up our cemetery **Upper Calvary**- the perennials garden was refreshed with new plantings and freshly added mulch.
