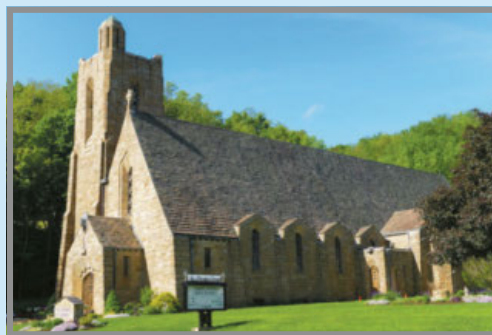

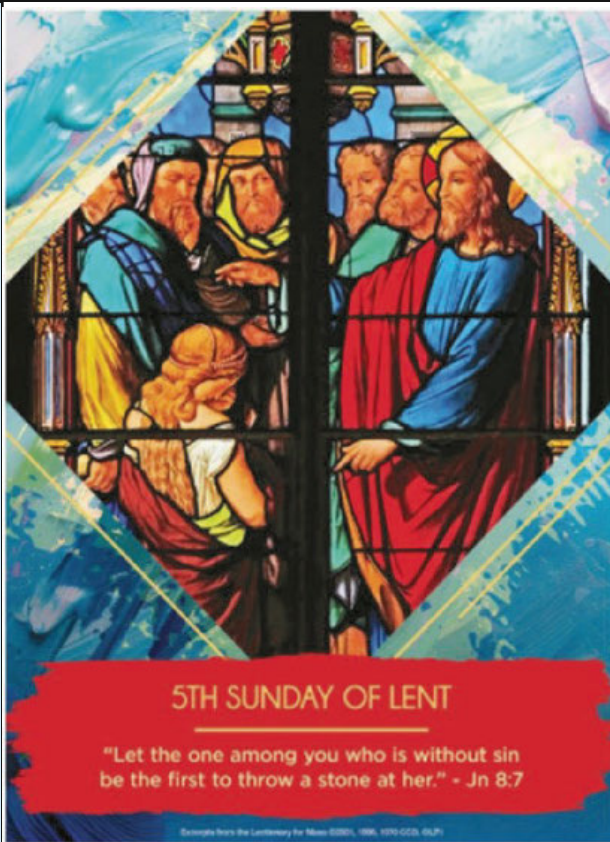

A Day of Prayer and Adoration

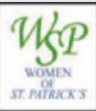
Wednesday, April 9




